VTC and Hong Kong Technology Venture Company Limited (HKTV) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 31 January 2024. Through this MoU, VTC and HKTV will collaborate on training programmes for "live commerce" talents. HKTVmall's live streaming experts will conduct workshops and seminars for students from the Higher Diploma programmes in Business Discipline at the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (IVE). Additionally, HKTV will extend full support to the HKVTC Shop 第二屆電商王大賽.

Furthermore, students from the Business Discipline will have the opportunity to participate in the production of live commerce events on the "HKTVLive" Shopping Channel. Meanwhile, under VTC's Workplace Learning and Assessment (WLA) framework, internship opportunities at HKTVmall and other merchants will be provided to students.

- ESG ideals are espoused in Kenyan legislation within the provisions of the Constitution of Kenya 2010
- With respect to environmental ideals, the right to a clean and healthy environment is set out as a fundamental human right in Article 42 of the Constitution
- Article 69 of the Constitution imposes an obligation on the Government of Kenya (GoK) to protect and conserve the environment.
- It further renders its guidance to land management in articles 60 and 66 by emphasising the principles promoting sustainable exploitation, utilisation, management and preservation of the environment.



Students from DFS (Business) attended a professional webinar "Kenya's ESG Contents and Sustainability in 2024" delivered by EarthLungs Reforestation Foundation on 8 February 2024. The objective of the webinar was to inspire young people to work and pursue their career in Kenya and the Mainland cities of the GBA. The guest speaker, Mr. Victor Mwanga, CEO of EarthLungs Reforestation Foundation, shared his perspective with students on the investment analysis and decisions with focuses on the analysis of environmental, social, and governance (ESG) factors. Speakers elaborated recent development of accountancy industry, shared success stories in commercial sector and industry establishment, explained requirements of various accounting professional bodies and tips to plan for professional qualifications.
